During the 1st round mens match between Andy Murray and Yen-Hsun Lu, a challenge was made by Yen-Hsun Lu on a serve at set point in the first set. The original serve was called good by the line judge, and was later called out by Hawk-Eye technology.

Unfortunately for viewers/spectators it appeared as though Hawk-Eye wasn't working as:

1. The visual representation of the line call was unavailable within the stadium due to a problem with the big screen.
2. The chair umpire described the replay as "unavailable".

However due to the failsafe methods adopted by both the ITF and Hawk-Eye the review was available, and in fact used. The resident ITF official within the Hawk-Eye booth was able to radio the result of the challenge to the chair umpire who then announced the decision of the challenge.
